

CHC33015 Certificate III in Individual Support (Ageing)

Course Description

The Certificate III in Individual Support (Ageing Specialisation) gives you the skills and training to understand the important role of workers in the community and/or residential setting. These workers follow an individualised plan to provide person-centred support to people who may require support due to ageing, disability or some other reason. Work involves using discretion and judgement in relation to individual support as well as taking responsibility for own outputs. Workers have a range of factual, technical and procedural knowledge, as well as some theoretical knowledge of the concepts and practices required to provide person-centred support.

Student Requirements

Students must 17 or 18 years old to enrol in this course. Students must be prepared to complete their study once a week conducted off campus. Bring a Lap top, lined pad paper and a pen.

Course Prerequisites

Students should have an interest in the Aged Care Sector and have good communication skills. Students need to complete the DCSI clearance process at the time of enrolment. Queensford College can assist with this. We recommend that students have both their DCSI clearance and national police clearance for placement purposes.

Structured Work Placement

120 hours of work placement is compulsory for this qualification. Students will learn valuable practical skills and knowledge whilst meeting their unit requirements. The work placement may take place during the school holidays and Queensford College will assist students in finding their placements. Before students are placed they need to complete First Aid, Manual Handling and have their DCSI clearance and or National Police clearance. *"Students are expected to perform support activities such as personal care activities with clients while on Vocational Placement."* We encourage students to find their own placements if they have specific centres in mind as we cannot guarantee to place students in their local area.
